CHAPTER XXVI.

The following version of this Chapter is copied from an electrotype (Brit. Mus., No. 29,553), made from the original inscribed stone which formerly belonged to the Empress Catherine of Russia. It was accidentally discovered in the Imperial Collection of Antiquities, by the Emperor Nicholas, and was by him presented to General Peroffsky, one of his high officials. An impression was taken from the stone by Mr. Khanikoff, and was presented by Mr. Stevens to the Hon. C. A. Murray, British Minister to Persia in 1856. The electrotype measures $6\frac{7}{8}$ inches by 6 inches.


